

Pet Policy

- o Animals should not be unattended on patios or balconies
- o Tenant is responsible for immediately cleaning up any animal defecation. Animal defecation must be managed as follows:

Cats- inside the litter box only

Dogs- outside, around the perimeter of the community.

Failure to clean up after your pet will result in a \$100 violation fee, and \$200 for each occurrence following the first violation.

- o Animals must not disturb neighbors or others in and around the apartment community, whether the animals are inside or outside the Premises.
- o Animals must not be tied to any fixed object anywhere outside the Premises
- o Animals must not be let into swimming pool areas, offices, club rooms, or other recreational facilities or common areas.
 - *Service Animals performing their designated service may receive exceptions.*
- o Animals must not be fed or watered outside your designated cottage.
- o No more than two pets per unit are permitted.
- o Cats must be neutered.
- o Animals must be kept on a leash and under the Tenant's supervision and control when outside of the Premises. Failure to leash your pet may result in a pet violation fine.
 - The Landlord or Landlord's representative has the right to pick up unleashed animals or report them to the proper authorities.
- o Visiting animals, other than service animals, are not allowed.
 - Pets must be registered with the leasing office PRIOR to coming onto the property. Roommate consent is required prior to any arriving pets. Unregistered pets may result in a \$100 violation fee for each day the pet is not registered.

PETS PROHIBITED

- o Animals weighing over 85 lbs.
- o Aggressive Breeds such as but not limited to: Akita, Doberman Pincher, Rottweiler, Dalmatian, Pit Bull, Chow, Wolf Hybrid, German Shepard, and Bull Mastiff, as well as any mix of the listed breeds.
- o Exotic animals: Exotic birds, snakes, ferret, parrots, and toucans
